## Square Foot Gardening

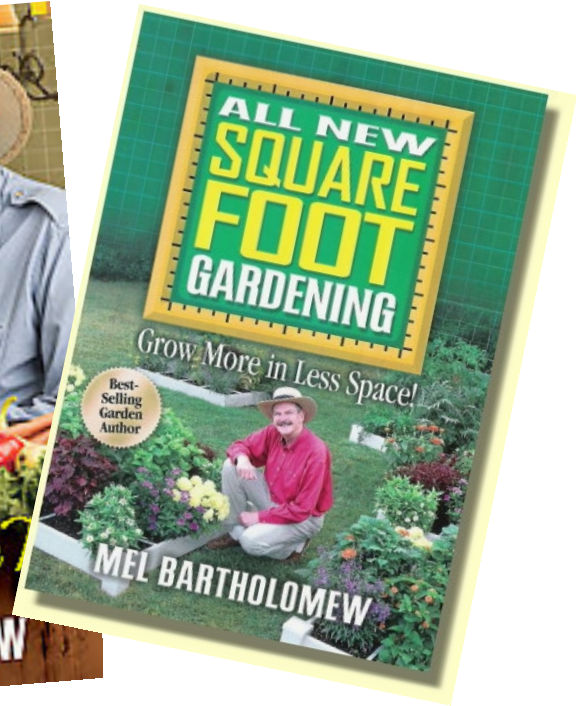
